Steffprint wins Metro deal

Steffprint will print all of public transport service Metro's print work for the next three years after successfully renewing its £159,000 contract.

The Yorkshire-based litho printer will use a six-colour Heidelberg XL 105 and a four-colour Komori B2 press to print timetables, leaflets and brochures for the West Yorkshire firm. The contract will last for three years.

Steffprint managing director Michael Watson said: "It's very nice to have been chosen for the tender over stiff competition. We have worked on and off with Metro for more than 25 years and, as one of the most modern sheetfed printers in the North East, we feel up to the task."
