Steffprint orders Speedmaster XL105

Steffprint in Keighley, West Yorkshire is to increase its capacity and turnover after ordering a Heidelberg Speedmaster XL105.

The five-colour press is capable of speeds up to 18,000sph and will replace a five-colour, 15,000sph CD102 at the firm, which specialises in mail order work and trade work.

Michael Watson, managing director of Steffprint, said: "Heidelberg says the Speedmaster XL105 will give us 30% more productivity than the five year old CD 102 we are replacing - if it can do half the work I will be impressed."

Steffprint, which has a turnover of around £3m, runs both B1 and B2 presses 24 hours, five days a week.

Watson said: "This investment is good news for existing clients and will attract new business as part of our planned growth towards a £3.75m turnover this financial year."

By the end of 2006 the company will also have completed a two storey office extension and is planning to revamp its company logo and branding.
